Wunan manages the Child & Parent Centres (CPCs) in Kununurra & Halls Creek in partnership with the WA Department of Education.


Research shows that 90 per cent of a child's brain develops by the age of three. So the experiences they have during this time impact on their success at school and in later life.

Home Interaction Program for Parents & Youngsters (HIPPY)

HIPPY is a two-year, home-based parenting & early childhood enrichment program that works with parents to help them guide their preschool-aged children's early learning experiences.
