Competition Period	The competition commences at 8am on Saturday 27/05/2017 and entries must be submitted no later than 5pm on Tuesday 04/07/2017. The competition will conclude with an Exhibition and Judging of the final submissions on Friday 7 July 2017 to be held at Wunan Foundation, 76 Cnr Messmate Way and Coolibah Drive, Kununurra WA 6743 – 9am to 2pm. We encourage all entrants to attend this exhibition and join in the Wunan Community Fair Day Celebrations are part of NAIDOC Week 2017.
Who may enter	Entry is open only to Aboriginal and Torres Straight Islanders of the East Kimberley Region. Entrants must be 13 years of age and over.
Maximum number of entries per individual entrant	No limit.
Additional entry instructions	DESIGN REQUIREMENTS: Colour palette reflective of the Kimberley region / culture. Must be original works – you must have permission to use the design/story – you must not currently be affiliated with a commercial or community gallery of cultural centre. Design must reflect the 2017 NAIDOC Week theme: 'Our Languages Matter', depicting stories of the Kimberley region – see www.naidoc.org.au for more information

COMPETITION SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

All designs must be submitted in print, paper, canvas or graphic design (electronic file – Jpeg, TIFF or EPS) formats.

Size: 6:4 ratio (width:height) is recommended otherwise the work may be edited for reproduction purposes. Minimum size for submissions is 60cm x 40cm or larger.

Print/Paper/Canvas based works: originals must be submitted for display for the exhibition and judging process.

Digital works: must supply a printed copy for the exhibition and judging requirements and the original digital file for reproduction purposes.

Digital Works: Min. 150 - 200 DPI / 300 PPI / File no larger than 1MG
All artworks will be returned upon conclusion of the competition.

Judging process	Entries will be judged by an independent committee of Judges enlisted by the EKAAA Organising Committee
Judging criteria	Originality; creativity; how well the work reflects the theme; how well the design will transfer for reproduction into a large 6m x 4m printed banner.
Judging date	Friday 07/07/2017 – at the Wunan Community Fair Day, 9am – 2pm at 76 Cnr Messmate Way and Coolibah Drive, Kununurra
Prize winner notification	All entries will be displayed prior to Judging. Judging will take place on the day and the winner will be announced upon completion of the judging process. All entrants are encouraged to attend the Wunan Community Fair Day. However, winners will be notified by email / phone on the date of judging, and results will be displayed on the Wunan website and social media platforms.
Special condition	All right, title and interest in the intellectual property rights (IPRs) arising out of this Competition are owned by Wunan Foundation and, to the extent needed, the supplier (or competition winner, whatever the appropriate term) hereby assigns any right, title or interest it may have now or in the future in these IPRs to Wunan Foundation.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The artwork must reflect the theme:
'Our Languages Matter'
2. There are no limits on the number of entries. Entries may be submitted via the following methods:

3. The entrant acknowledges that their artwork may be copied or reproduced for the purposes as outlined within the Terms & Conditions.
4. All participating entrants state that they are 13 years or older at the time the Entry Form is submitted; the artwork submitted is original work; the artwork submitted has not been the recipient of a major prize before; and that they have not charged or otherwise encumbered the work nor given any assignment inconsistent with these terms and conditions. Where a participating entrant is under the age of 18, the artist's parent / guardian must complete the Entry Form by stating their own name on behalf of the name of the entrant to indicate their agreement with these terms and conditions on behalf of the entrant.
5. All entrants undertake to indemnify and keep indemnified Wunan Foundation Inc. against all claims, demands, losses and damages that Wunan Foundation incurs as a result of a breach of any warranties and obligations given by Entrants under these terms and conditions.
6. By signing a completed Entry Form, submitting and artwork / design and accepting the award offer, the winning entrant:
 - Grants to Wunan Foundation Inc., a permanent, royalty free, worldwide, irrevocable, ongoing, non-exclusive licence (including a right of sub-licence) to use, reproduce, communicate, broadcast, publish, distribute, adapt, modify the winning entry in all media of expression now known or later developed and in all languages, for any purposes associated with Wunan Foundation and other Indigenous engagement initiatives, including but not limited to, reproducing and publishing the winning entry by way of a large format banner (6m x 4m) to be used in conjunction with the East Kimberley Aboriginal Achievement Award (EKAAA) 2017, or for any other event, educational purpose or activity;
 - Consents to any of the following types of acts or omissions by Wunan Foundation Inc.; (a) use of all or part of the art work in accordance with the licence granted above, with or without attribution of authorship to the artist (but the Commonwealth will not falsely attribute authorship of the entry); (b) supplementing the art work with any other material; and (c) use of the art work in a different context to that originally envisaged;
 - May be requested to physically sign a licence and consent form relating to the art work, prior to the completion being finalised. Failure to sign the licence will entitle Wunan Foundation Inc. to remove the artist's entry from the Competition.
 - Agrees that Wunan Foundation Inc. may publish, reproduce in whole, or in part, and display by way of a large formatted printed banner (6m x 4m) the work at the 2017 East Kimberley Aboriginal Achievement Awards and in any other material in which the art work / design is reproduced.

- Agrees that there is no cultural or religious reason or any other impediment that prevents the winning artwork / design from being exhibited, published or reproduced.
7. Wunan Foundation Inc. is the Promoter of this Competition.
 8. Final selection may be subject to the provision of additional information. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of participating entrants, artwork / design and Entry Form (including entrant's identity, age and place of residence) and to disqualify any entrant who submits an Entry Form that is not in accordance with these Competition Terms and Conditions or who tampers with the entry process.
 9. These Terms & Conditions ("Terms") apply to the game of skill described in Part A (the "Competition").
 10. The Competition will be conducted by Wunan Foundation Inc. during the period specified in Part A (the "Competition Period").
 11. The Terms may be amended or replaced by Wunan Foundation in its absolute discretion and at any time.
 12. Entry into the Competition is deemed acceptance of the Terms (as amended from time to time).
 13. Entry is open to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people of the East Kimberley Region and must be aged 13 years or older at the time the entry form is submitted. No group entries will be accepted.
 14. Each entrant warrants that their entry is not, and its use by the Promoter or other persons will not infringe the rights (including intellectual property rights) of any third party.
 - 15. The following are NOT permitted to enter the contest: artists who are currently employed by, or affiliated with a commercial or indigenous owned art and / or cultural centre within the East Kimberley region (refer to point 14.)**
 16. Each entrant is responsible for notifying the Promoter of any changes to his/her residential address, email address or phone number during and after the Competition period.
 17. A decision of the Promoter in relation to the conduct of the Competition, including the selection of winning entries, is binding and conclusive and no correspondence will be entered into.
 18. Unless otherwise specified in Part A, winners will be notified by phone and/or email within 2 business days after the judging date. Each entrant consents to Wunan Foundation Inc. publishing details of a winner or winning entry on its website and social media platforms.
 19. Prizes are not transferable or redeemable for cash.
 20. As the prize includes a voucher, the prize is valid until the expiry date specified on the voucher or ticket (or its provider), and subject to the conditions stipulated by the provider. Such prizes cannot be redeemed for further vouchers
 21. The Promoter may, in its absolute discretion, disqualify:
 - a) any entry which is not original, is not completed in accordance with these Terms, infringes the intellectual property rights of any third party, contains any objectionable content, or has the potential to damage the reputation of any person; or
